- Week 1: June 22 - 26:** **The Deep Blue Sea**

- Week 2: June 29 – July 3:** **Happy Birthday Canada** **(4-day week)**
Canada, it's your birthday! In this camp, we will learn about the confederation, provinces and territories of Canada. We'll create red and white crafts that symbolize Canada and have a show & tell to showcase how much we know about our great country!
- Week 3: July 6 - 10:** **Mad Science**
Have you ever wondered why some objects float while others don't? Would you like to make an erupting volcano using only the supplies you could find at home? Come join us to explore the magic of science!
